VOLUNTEER FOR ART FOR MORE THAN ART'S SAKE

Portland designer and sustainability advocate Owen William Fritts has conceived an exciting new art installation for display at the upcoming Cascade AIDS Project art auction, and he needs help from the community in bringing it to life. Called a "STORYpod", the piece will be an organic structure of hand-woven branches entwined with personal messages, memories and stories about HIV/AIDS.

Volunteers of all ages are invited to participate in the STORYpod's creation, from the initial building and assembly to final adornment events called "laceUPS", where anyone with a message to contribute can write it down and tie it to the STORYpod using a special nike(RED) shoelace.

The result will be a living, growing testament of the collective strength and support of the community in the fight against HIV/AIDS.
